Alexandre Barbosa de Brito, AB Vista LATAM Technical Manager, will deliver a TECHTalk on 'Utilising Dietary Fiber for Optimal Performance' on 1 February, in Hall A, Booth A244, at 10.30am. The talk will cover advancements in the understanding of fiber, the impact it has on poultry performance and tools that can be used in day-to-day formulations to monitor and utilise fiber for optimal results.
