The presentation, 'A novel technology for testing the intestinal health status of broilers in the field to support flock resilience, profitability and efficiency', will share more on the technology developed by AB Vista, and its successful application in broiler chickens. It will take place on Wednesday 29 January at 4pm EST.

 4pm-6pm EST: 'Blood biochemistry influenced by dietary available phosphorus and phytase supplementation', will explore the advantages of using higher doses of phytase in phosphate-free diets, focusing on growth performance, bone mineralisation and blood biochemistry.
