Supplied on a three-year contract hire deal, the DAF trucks will join a fleet operating from the firm's nine distribution depots, including Peterlee, Luton, Sheffield and Bradford. The multi-temperature Chereau fridge will work out of the company's County Durham headquarters.

Jason Brooksbank, Group Transport Manager at Eden Farm Hulleys, says: "We're expanding and refreshing our fleet after winning some new business and the DAF trucks and Chereau trailer meet our requirements.

"We have operated DAF tractor units for a number of years and trialled a New Generation DAF XF 480 prior to placing our order. The fuel return statistics were favourable, which is fantastic as we work them hard on our trunking operations across the UK. They will clock up around 180,000 km per year. The DAF maintenance and back-up service from Asset Alliance Group is also excellent."

Featuring a spacious cab, the trucks are specified with a built-in satellite navigation system and a range of cameras to help mitigate ambiguous insurance claims and aid driver safety.

"They offer excellent cab comfort and have proven popular with our drivers," Brooksbank says.

Joining a mixed fleet of 180 trucks, trailers and delivery vans, the new vehicles will be used to distribute frozen and chilled food products and ice cream to a wide range of customers, from small independent shops, through to large wholesalers and buying groups, as well as a number of high street retailers.

Eden Farm Hulleys, part of the Kitwave Group, an independent wholesale business with depots throughout the UK, has worked with Asset Alliance Group previously, sourcing a number of trailers five years ago.

"We teamed up with Asset Alliance Group again because of their ability to quickly source the assets we need to help grow our business. They were competitively priced and arrived on time. We're delighted with the high level of service," adds Brooksbank.
