CAERDAV DELIVERS AN AIRBUS A320 TRANSITION CHECK FOR AVOLON AS PART OF NEW MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

After signing a new General Maintenance Agreement with Avolon – one of the world’s largest aviation leasing companies – Caerdav successfully completed a first transition check on an Airbus A320 in readiness for operation in Spain.

The aircraft, which previously flew in Asia, underwent an extensive transition process which included a comprehensive airframe maintenance check, alongside the scheduled replacement of engine number two, following a full boroscope inspection – all in readiness to enter service with Barcelona-based low-cost carrier, Volotea.
