On the larger vehicles, Carrier Transicold's powerful Supra system is able to provide constant airflow, independent of engine speed, offering operators rapid pull-down and accurate multi-temperature set point control. The flexible Supra units supply consistent frozen and chilled performance, also making them the ideal choice for high intensity delivery schedules.

Operating out of six depots across the UK, the new rental vehicles will be available for hire nationwide, and each vehicle is backed with a Carrier Transicold everCOLD™ maintenance contract to minimise downtime.
